Travelling to the London Clinic Eye Centre

The London Clinic Eye Centre is located at 119 Harley Street W1G 6AU. This is at the North End of Harley Street close to the junction with Marylebone Road.

By Public Transport

The closest London Underground stations are as follows:

Numerous black taxis pass all these stations if you do not wish to walk. Paddington, Marylebone, Euston, King's Cross and St Pancras Mainline Rail Stations are all a short bus, tube or taxi ride away.

By car

Parking near the Eye Centre is busy on-street parking on Harley Street and surrounding roads. Parking must be paid for by phone or using the Ring-Go App. There are two 24 hour secure Q-Park car-parks nearby (10-15 min walk): Queen Anne Mews W1G 9HF and Cavendish Square W1G 0PN. The London Clinic has negotiated a 15% discount for hospital visitors when a booking is made on-line (please see https://www.thelondonclinic.co.uk/contact-us/parking-at-the-london-clinic for booking details).
